Infrastructure & Mushrooms on Cedar

watercolor and gouache on aquaboard and birch panel;

Local indigenous communities used ancient cedars to build homes and boats. Mushroom mycelium provides a network of connections throughout the forest. Our modern infrastructure is built with concrete and metal instead of plants that flourish in our native environment.

The flowers, leaves, and roots of Dandelion are all edible. They are a wonderful food that multiplies prolifically in the most challenging spaces making them a food factory.

This inspiration for this series was an abandoned diner where fireweed flourished in the unkept landscape. Fireweed is an edible native plant, and a pioneer species, that quickly establishes itself after a fire, logging, or avalanche.

Mullein is one of the most medicinal native plants and can be used as an expectorant. Its ability to grow almost anywhere is why many consider this sacred medicinal plant a weed.

Dogbane, known for its strength & flexibility, has been used by local indigenous communities to make traditional functional items like baskets.

Fast Fat & Mallow

Mallow leaves are more nutritious than spinach and can grow in tough urban environments. The roots of the variety that grows in marshes (marsh mallow) are used to make marshmallows.

Dandelion roots taste great when flame broiled and roasted, are anti-inflammatory, and can grow in the cracks of an abandoned fast food restaurant parking lot.
